ISO 50001

Implementing the energy management standard ISO 50001 makes good business sense as part of a structured and coordinated approach to reducing energy use.

Why ISO 50001?

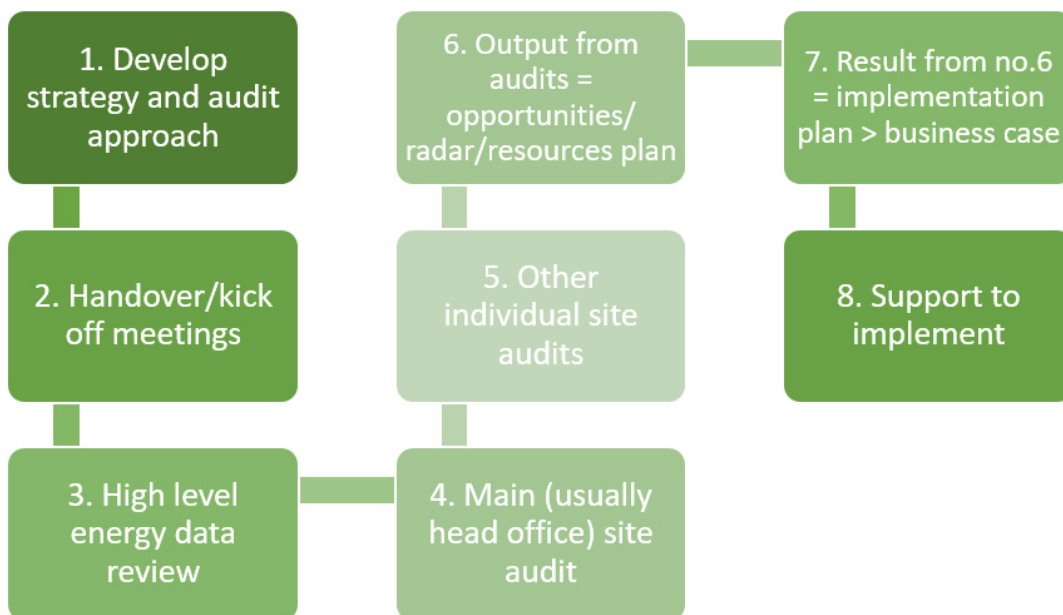

JRP can help you every step of the way to certification and beyond, starting with a very robust audit of representative sites, as well as the organisation as a whole, to see how far from the standard you are.

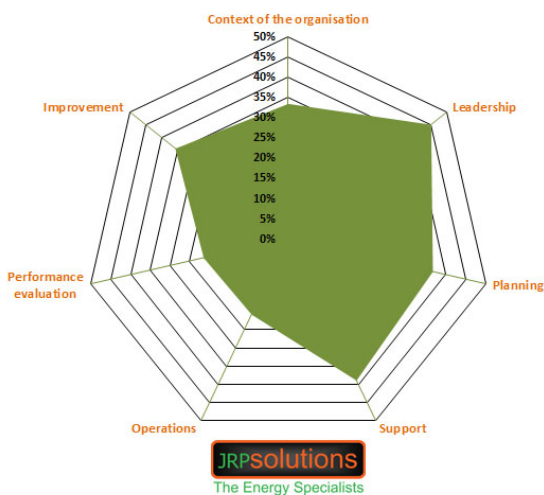

From gap analysis to action plan

Using our ISO 50001 Gap Analysis Tool, we will score a level of compliance to each of 114 questions, divided into 7 key areas. JRP will recommend actions or evidence required in each area to achieve certification and will produce a radar chart for each site audited to give a visual indication of the progress required against each of the 7 main elements of the standard.



These recommendations go into 'Consolidated Action Plan' from which we determine resources and

potential savings to create a costed business case and implementation plan for each item.

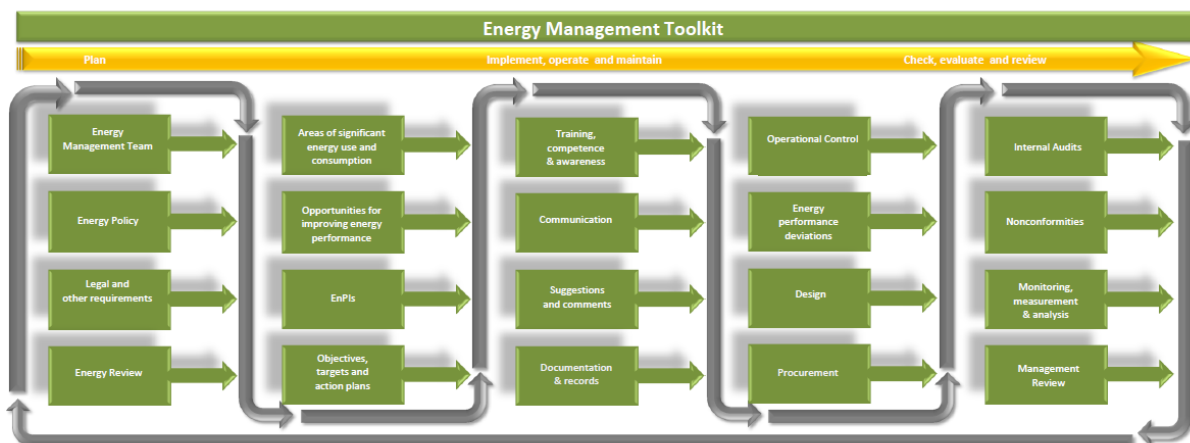
The Consolidated Action Plan is a dynamic document which can be used and updated throughout implementation. JRP can support you to deliver all actions required to achieve certification.


Simplified management
